

The next meeting of the RF&P RR Historical Society will be held on Saturday, May 17, 10 am, and will take place at the Chancellor Community Center facility located at 7300 Old Plank Road in Fredericksburg, VA. This is the first time that the Society has met at this location and therefore the following directions and cautions are necessary. The Chancellor Community Center building itself is located just a mile or so further west than the library we had been using. However, arriving at the location may require some additional planning and care.

DIRECTIONS TO MEETING

Traveling on I-95 (From the North or South):

Go west on Route 3 (Exit 130-B) towards Culpeper, VA
Proceed approximately 4.4 miles to the traffic light at Andora Drive
Turn **left** onto Andora Drive.
Go to the end of Andora Drive and you will come to a “T” intersection with Old Plank Road.
This is a 3-Way Stop intersection with NO stoplight, which means you must utilize good driving skills and courtesy. BE CAREFUL.

The Chancellor Community Center facility will be on the other side of the “T” and to your right.

Turn RIGHT onto Old Plank Road, and then almost an immediate LEFT into the parking lot. Vehicles coming in the opposite direction may not leave room for you to make this turn, so you may have to wait.

BE VERY CAREFUL OF ONCOMING TRAFFIC ON OLD PLANK ROAD !!!!!!!!!

Traveling on Route 3:

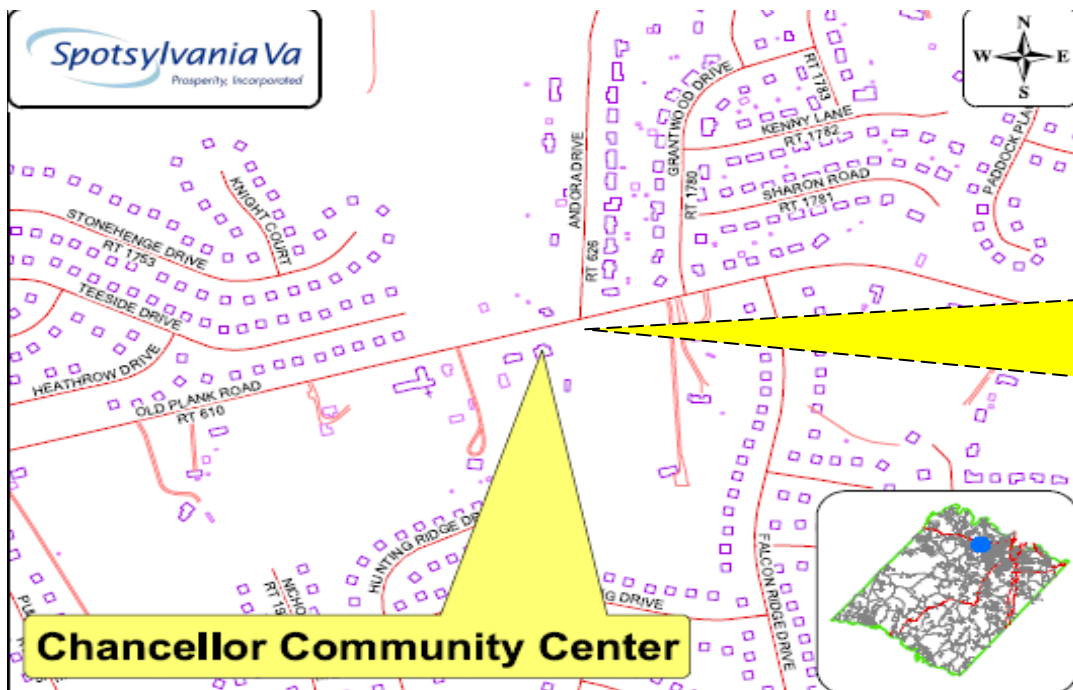
From the **West**: At Andora Drive traffic light, turn **right** off of Route 3 and onto Andora Drive
From the **East**: At Andora Drive traffic light, turn **left** off of Route 3 and onto Andora Drive

Go to the end of Andora Drive and you will come to a “T” intersection with Old Plank Road.
This is a 3-Way Stop intersection with NO stoplight, which means you must utilize good driving skills and courtesy. BE CAREFUL.

The Chancellor Community Center facility will be on the other side of the “T” and to your right.

Turn RIGHT onto Old Plank Road, and then almost an immediate LEFT into the parking lot. Vehicles coming in the opposite direction may not leave room for you to make this turn, so you may have to wait.
